Innovation & Creativity	Proposal is unique or distinctly creative. Illustrates an innovative approach for addressing a specific issue. Participants would be highly engaged. Participants would enjoy the activity.	Not creative or innovative, with minimal engagement or enjoyment by participants.
Proposal Description	Proposal is clear, thoughtful, and is strongly evidence based.	Proposal is well-written and generally good, with some emphasis on outcomes.	Proposal is somewhat vague and lacking clarity around purpose and goals, but still seems reasonable	Poor proposal description, no obvious goals or desired outcomes.
Impact on Trainees	Potential for profoundly impacting a significant number of diverse participants.	Significant impact on good number of diverse participants.	Positive impact on small and relatively homogeneous group.	Unclear how it will make a positive impact on participants.
Budget	Budget outlines in detail how the money will be spent including where funds are going, prices, quantity of materials purchased, titles of specific materials and shipping.	Budget gives information about what is purchased, from where and how much, but lacks specifics.	Budget is defined only in general terms and is missing specific information.	Budget is missing or does not align with the proposed project.
Cost Effectiveness	The proposal seems like an excellent use of Feuerstein funds. Excellent benefit for cost.	The proposal seems like a good use of the Feuerstein fund. Very good benefit for cost.	The proposal is a justifiable use of the Feuerstein fund. Moderate benefit for cost.	The proposal seems like a poor use of the Feuerstein fund. Little to no benefit for the cost.
Likelihood of Implementation	The proposed activity is straight forward and requires little coordination or organization.
